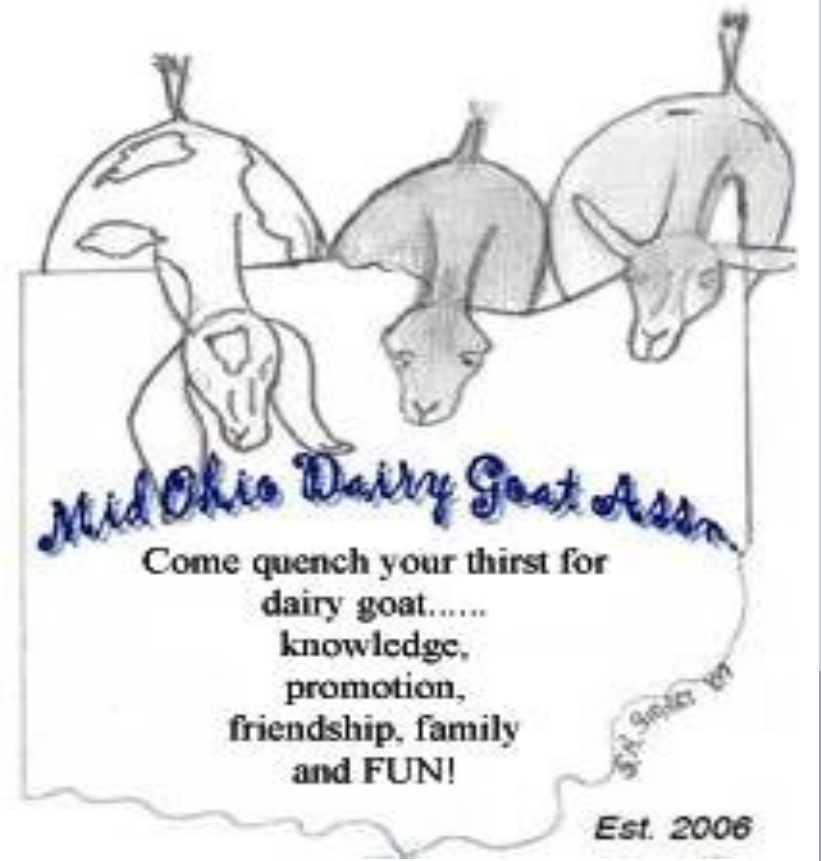

WEAR YOUR BEST Whites and Put your best shine on those show animals as we will be taking PHOTOS of ALL of the Specialty Winners AND all of the GCH, RGCH and BIS show winners.

MODGA does not require that your animals be clipped to be shown in this show. We understand that it is the first show of the season and the weather is unpredictable. Clipping is up to the decision of each exhibitor. Clean animals with a dairy trim is perfectly acceptable.

Show Rules

ADGA RULES SHALL GOVERN.

This show is separately sanctioned by ADGA for Junior & Senior Does in Alpine, Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Recorded Grade, AOP, Toggenburg. Bucks are sanctioned for Lamancha, Toggenburg, Nigerian Dwarf, and AOP. Show Order will be as follows:

Ring 1: Alpine, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Recorded Grade, AOP, Toggenburg, and Lamancha. With the exception of Lamancha showing 1st in the Jr Division. Bucks: Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, AOP, and Toggenburg.

Ring 2: AOP, Recorded Grade, Oberhasli, Nubian, Nigerian Dwarf, Lamancha, Alpine, and Toggenburg. With the exception of Toggenburg showing 1st in the Jr. Division. Bucks: Toggenburg, AOP, Nigerian Dwarf, and Lamancha.

Ring 3: Nubian, Oberhasli, Recorded Grade, AOP, Toggenburg, Alpine, Lamancha, and Nigerian Dwarf. Bucks: AOP, Toggenburg, Lamancha, and Nigerian Dwarf.

The order of the show **IS** subject to change to avoid delays when possible.

Original registration papers (required for animals six months of age or older) or stamped duplicates must be shown to the show secretary before the start of the show.

The base date shall be the date of the show, in this case May 2, 2020.

Entries will be taken until 8:00 A.M. for Sr and Jr does on the day of the show, Entries will be taken until 2:00 P.M. for Bucks on the day of the show. All open show animals must be in place prior to these times.

Ohio State Health Rules shall govern and the Health Committee's decision is final. All animals must show no evidence of caseous lymphadenitis (superficial abscesses), contagious ecthyma (sore mouth), foot rot, or other contagious diseases. **ALL ANIMALS MUST BE HEALTHY. A VETERINARIAN WILL BE ON SITE FOR ANY UNHEALTHY OR QUESTIONABLE ANIMALS AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE.** Animals

SPECIALTY GROUP CLASSES

ANIMALS USED IN GROUP CLASSES MUST BE SHOWN IN INDIVIDUAL CLASSES.

Animals do not have to be owned by one individual.

Group classes follow the end of their individual breed classes

These are the group classes to follow the senior doe show

Senior Get of Sire: Three does from the Senior Doe Show sired by the same buck.

Dairy Herd: Four Does in milk, owned by the same exhibitor

Best Udder: Does, regardless of age, will be judged in a single class. This class must be entered to be eligible. (Animals will NOT be placed on udder in individual classes).

These are the group classes to follow the junior doe show

Produce of Dam: Two does, any age, the produce of the same dam.

Dam & Daughter: Dam with any age daughter. Both in milk preferred but dry is acceptable.

Breeder's Trio: Three does any age bred by the exhibitor.

Junior Get of Sire: Three does from the Junior Doe Show sired by the same buck.

Best Three Jr. Does: From any age group in the junior show.

This is the only group class to follow the buck show

Sire & Son: Sire with any age son.

originating from out of state must have a certificate of veterinary inspection issued within ninety days preceding the exhibition. ACCREDITED AND CERTIFIED HERDS FROM OUT OF OHIO STILL NEED 90 DAY HEALTH PAPERS. No health papers are required for goats originating from Ohio. GOATS ARE TO ARRIVE ONLY DURING THE TIMES NOTED AND ARE NOT TO BE UNLOADED UNTIL THE HEALTH CHECK HAS BEEN COMPLETED. EXHIBITORS MUST PRESENT THEIR HEALTH CHECK-IN CARD AT THE SECRETARIES TABLE FOR CHECK-IN. Anyone requiring veterinary services will be responsible for the charges.

No pre-show milk out. No horned animals allowed. We strongly believe it is unethical and inhumane to bag animals for more than 18 hours or seal teats with anything but colodium.

Animals arriving for a class after it has entered the ring will not be permitted to compete and will forfeit their entry fee.

All Bucks over 6 months of age must be secured properly to prevent "escapes".

NO dogs are allowed in the barn or arena area.

NO alcoholic beverages are allowed on the fairgrounds. Mid-Ohio Dairy Goat Association and the Morrow County Agricultural Society will not be held responsible for losses, damages, or accidents. Any person or family not acting in a honorable manner will be required to leave IMMEDIATELY from the grounds of the show and no refunds will be offered. **Children under 11 must be accompanied by an adult, no minors under 18 should be on the grounds without parental supervision.**

Camping is available on the fairgrounds with water and electric hook-ups for \$35.00 **per night**. Please pay and get your permit when you check in.

Vendors are welcome! Charges are \$25.00 or a raffle item donation of equal value. Please indicate on the entry form if space is needed. Tables will NOT be furnished.

The Show Committee Reserves the right to interpret any rules not adequately covered by ADGA.
